KINGSMAN

A stable dual-purpose variety with a very high yielding capacity for the French fries industry, the export market and the table market.

Characteristics

- Mid-early variety
- Very good yield
- Large regular (round) oval tubers
- Also suitable for home fries and baker market
- Very drought tolerant and heat resistant
- Beautiful skin, popular with exporters and packers
- Suitable for almost all soil types
- Resistant to potato cyst nematodes
- On light soils, irrigation to prevent common scab is recommended
- Kingsman requires little N: 160-180 kg N, 2/3 basic and 1/3 after tuber setting



Cultivation

Animal manure may have a negative effect on crop maturity due to late mineralization in dry weather. This may affect dry matter and the formation of common scab. Kingsman has a slightly slower emergence given the variety develops a firm root system first, but this lag will certainly be made up.

Planting in 75 cm ridges

28/35 mm: 27-30 cm - 50.000 plants/ha - 1300-1400 kg/ha

35/55 mm: 35-38 cm - 38.000 plants/ha - 2400-2600 kg/ha

Kingsman is moderately susceptible to phytophthora in tuber and foliage. A standard spraying schedule is recommended to keep the crop healthy and vigorous.

Allow the crop to mature well before harvest and watch out for blueness. Kingsman has a good storability, but it's important to keep a stable temperature of 7 to 8 degrees Celsius.
